Services can be provided by phone or video technology.



Early Intervention is a **free**, voluntary program that can help families with their child's development, learning, and behavior.

Any child who you may have developmental concerns about can be referred.

After a referral is made, a **virtual** Multidisciplinary Evaluation (MDE) of child's development will take place.

If found eligible for services, the family will be part of a team that develops an individualized family service plan.
